New Certification Application Forms

Please be aware that we are in the process of transitioning to the new CA series forms. Several of the remaining forms were approved in regulation during the December meeting. The old TC version of the



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forms will be replaced by the new CA version. The only exceptions at this time are the TC-32 and the TC-161 forms. Once the new CA versions are loaded in the Forms Library in KECI, you will be able to access the new forms. If you have saved prior TC forms to your workstation or have made photocopies, please discard and discontinue use of those forms. For any of the old TC forms that may be in process currently, we will still accept the old version through the end of January. Beginning February 1, 2016, we will only accept the CA version of the most recently updated forms.

Spring LEAD and Highly Qualified Report

Spring LEAD reporting opened on Monday, January, 11, 2016, and closes on Monday, February, 29, 2016. That will be the last day for districts to sign off and submit their reports. Highly Qualified reporting opens March 1, 2016, and continues through March 31, 2016.

NBCT Applicants May Qualify for Reimbursement

The Kentucky Network to Transform Teaching (KYNT3) is offering financial assistance to teachers pursuing National Board certification who are from schools without National Board Certified Teachers.

To help achieve the goal outlined in a Kentucky statute of having one National Board Certified Teacher in every Kentucky school by 2020, KYNT3 will reimburse qualified candidates up to \$275 in out-of-pocket expenses after the submission of one NBCT component for as long as grant funding allows and in the order applications are received.

Combating Inappropriate Student-Teacher Relationship Task Force

The Combating Inappropriate Student-Educator Relationships Task Force will meet on Tuesday, February 2, 2016, at 11:00 a.m. EST at the EPSB offices in Frankfort. The purpose of the task force is to review current practices and policies relating to inappropriate student-educator relationships and make recommendations to combat such relationships.



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Online Educator Complaint System

This is a reminder to all district superintendents and human resource directors that the Online Educator Complaint System is up and running. This electronic reporting system is designed to assist districts with filing educator complaints and will expedite the process for resolving complaints within our Division of Legal Services. Superintendents now have access to the system and have the ability to assign a person within the district (e.g., a human resource director) to be her/his designee to submit items. We ask that you start using this system to report educator misconduct. When a report is submitted, the person filing the report receives a confirmation email.
